



COVID-19 Exposure & Control Plan – Adventure Camp

Hoodoo Adventure Co remains committed to providing a safe and healthy work and program space for all our participants and staff.

Physical Distancing

Social distancing is challenging in a youth setting. At the same time, it is extremely important, and we will do everything we can to try to assist children.

We are implementing the following Guidelines for our programs:

- Avoid close greetings like hugs or handshakes
- Help children to learn about social distancing by creating games.
- Have programs take place outside, wherever possible. We will aim to be outside 100% of the time in our programs.
- Regularly clean and sanitize items that are designed to be shared (ie. Handles and taps)
- Set up mini environments within the program to reduce the number of children in a group
- Set up distinct areas for children who may have symptoms of illness until they can be picked up.
- Food and drink sharing will not be permitted.
- Minimize the number of non-essential people in each program
- Reinforce and remind of the rule of “hands to yourself”.
- Regular hand washing. Mobile handwashing stations will be provided.
- Hand sanitizer will be added to personal gear lists
- Equipment will not be shared
- Marked equipment will be put in marked gear bins for each participant
- No toys, or personal items will be allowed at camp
- We will be avoiding use of shuttles unless for emergencies.

Screening participants

1. Phone and in person screening visitors, staff will ask questions about symptoms and potential exposure
2. Staff are to immediately contact a supervisor if they have any concerns based on answers given.
3. Anyone that is exhibiting any symptoms will not be allowed to attend camp
4. Any participant that is unable to follow the rules, after sufficient warning, will be removed from the program without reimbursement.

*Staff will be given intensive training on Covid-19 protocols and procedures in accordance with Health Authorities and Worksafe BC Guidelines.
